To Get a Card

- You can apply for the library card at any branch in person. Please ask our library staff.
- Fill out an application form.
- Bring your ID with name and proof of current address.

Accepted forms of identification: driver's license, health insurance card, student ID, residence card

Borrowing

- You can borrow books and magazines and more for 2weeks(a total of 10 items)
 Some specified books or magazines may borrow for 1week
- You can borrow Audiovisual materials for 1week(a total of 3 items)
 - ★Junior high school students and above are eligible to borrow those items.
