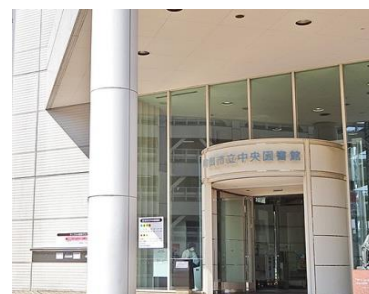
### ◎ Closing Days

### ◎ Get a Library Card Library card is necessary to borrow materials.

People eligible to get a card are as follows:

- Those who live in the following cities:  
City of Machida, Sagami-hara, Hachioji, Fuchu, Cho-fu, Hino,  
Tama, Inagi, Kawasaki, Yamato, Yokohama.
- Those who work or attend schools in Machida city.



### ◎ To Get a Card

- You can apply for the library card at any branch in person. Please ask our library staff.
- Fill out an application form.
- Bring your ID with name and proof of current address.

Accepted forms of identification: driver's license, health insurance card, student ID, residence card

## ◎ Borrowing

- You can borrow books and magazines and more for 2weeks( a total of 10 items)

Some specified books or magazines may borrow for 1week

- You can borrow Audiovisual materials for 1week( a total of 3 items)

★Junior high school students and above are eligible to borrow those items.

## ◎ How to Check out

### 【Self-Checkout Machines】

- For Books and Magazines, CDs, DVDs , VHS tapes and

Cassette tapes . . . **Use Self-Checkout Machine**



- Your library card is essential.



## ◎ Returning

### 【Self-Return Machines】

- For Books and Magazines . . . **Use Self-Return Machines**



- For CDs, DVDs, VHS tapes and Cassette tapes . . . Take the items to Return Counter on the 5th floor of Chuo Library.

## ◎ Book Drop (For returning when the Library is closed)

- You may return library books and magazines to the Book Drop outside the library when we are closed.
- But Audiovisual materials cannot be dropped off. Please take them directly to Return Counter of Chuo Library in open hours.
